

## DIRECTIONS TO RADISSON SAS HOTEL GLASGOW





## **BY CAR**

**From the East, South and North** - Exit the M8 at Junction 19 - SECC. At the traffic lights, carry straight on and then left at the next set of lights - onto the Broomielaw. Continue along the Broomielaw through three sets of traffic lights and turn left at the fourth set of lights onto Oswald Street. At the cross-roads, turn left onto Argyle Street. Radisson SAS Hotel Glasgow is on your left hand side.

**From the West** - Exit the M8 at Junction 18 - City Centre. Continue along Bothwell Street at the traffic lights. At the next set of lights turn right onto Wellington Street. Continue down Wellington Street straight through the next two sets of lights onto Robertson Street (the side of Radisson SAS Glasgow). At the next set of lights, turn left onto Broomielaw and then left again at the next lights onto Oswald Street. At the next lights turn left onto Argyle Street - you are now at the front of the Radisson SAS Hotel Glasgow.

**Parking** – We operate a valet parking service; simply pull up at the front door and hand us the keys. £9 for 24 hours. Alternatively, using the NCP car park on Oswald Street, Radisson SAS guests get at a reduced rate of £5 for each 24 hours in the car park. Don't forget to validate your ticket at Reception in order to get the reduced rate. The height restriction in the car park is 6ft 2" or 1.88 meters.

## **BY TRAIN**

**From Queen Street station** – Take the George Square exit, walk down Queen Street at the bottom turn right on to Argyle Street. Walk straight on under Central Station and we are in front of you. It's approximately a 12 minute walk. Alternatively under £5 in a taxi. **From Central Station** – Take the Hope Street or Argyle Street exit and cross over the road.

## **BY PLANE**

**From Glasgow International Airport** – A taxi will cost around £18. There is also a bus service (Glasgow Flyer) operated by Arriva - number 500, this service stops at Bothwell Street for Central Station and is £3.95 for a single taking about 25 minutes to get in. **From Prestwick International Airport** – A taxi will cost around £55. There is a train station at the airport which comes in to Central Station costing £5.85 for a single taking 45 minutes to get in to Central station.
