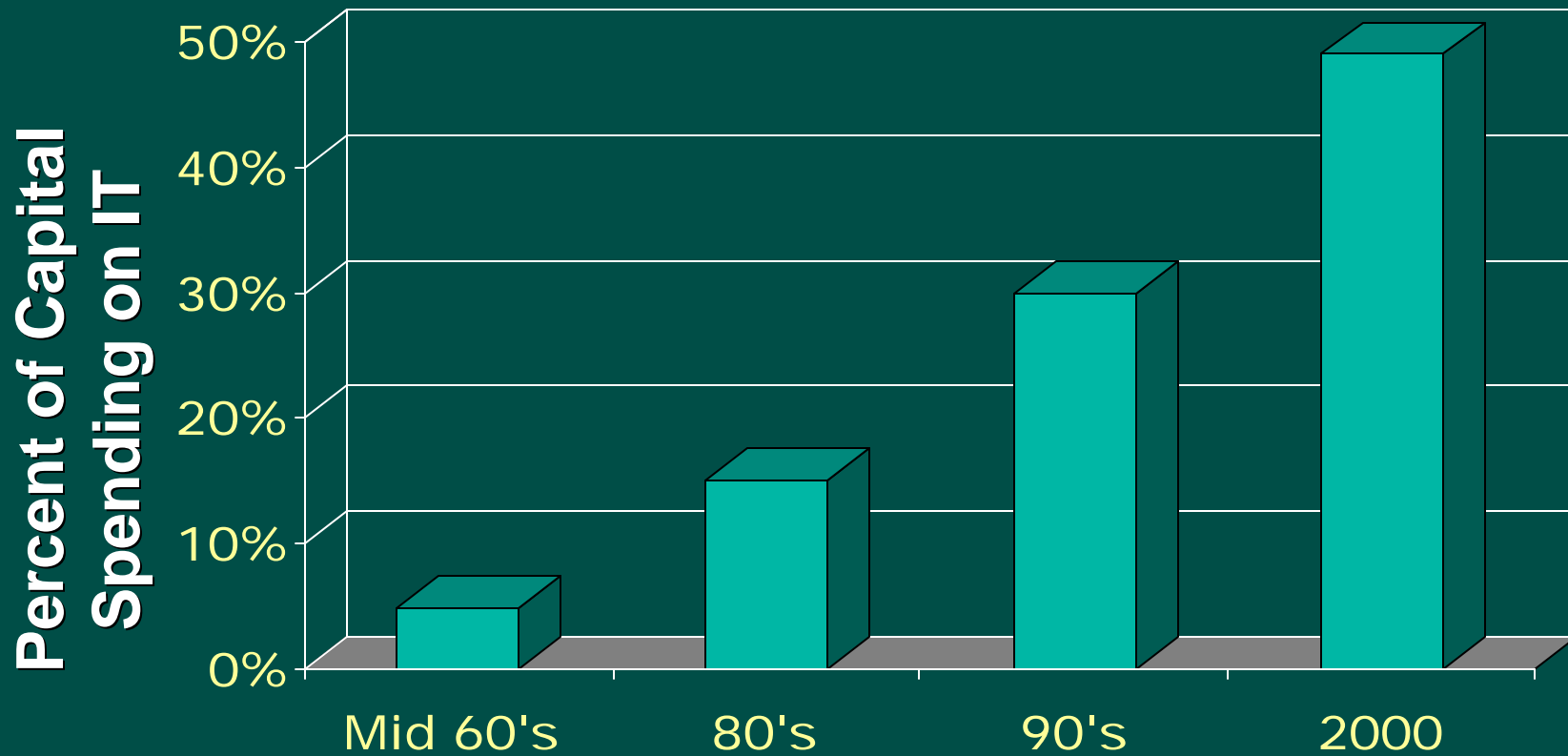


Is IT a Commodity?

- Ubiquity of IT
 - ◆ Cost of doing business
 - ◆ Harder to find a clear strategic value
 - ◆ Commodity factor of production
 - ◆ \$2 trillion annual global spend
- Strategic advantage implies scarcity.

Infrastructure Buildout

- Stage 1**
- Proprietary Technology & Practices
 - Few Standards, Rapid Change
 - Accessible to Few
 - Cost/Technical Barriers

***Early Adopters
Gain Competitive
Advantage***

- Stage 2**
- Rapid Adoption, Large Investment
 - Standards Emerge
 - Accessible to Many
 - Cost/Technical Barriers Fall

***Competition Grows,
Advantages Erode***

- Stage 3**
- Open Technology
 - Universal Standards
 - Affordable and Accessible
 - Excess Capacity
 - Business Necessity

***Competitive
Advantages Hard to
Find, Manage
Cost/Efficiency***





Customer View

- “I don’t want a system, I want a capability!”
- “Why can’t I seamlessly connect systems to share data?”
- “I don’t want to be dependent on a vendor’s proprietary solution”
- “Will your SW work with their system?”
- “I need more performance at lower cost.”



The Strategy

- **Broaden Standards Efforts**
 - ◆ Coalitions of standards bodies working in uniform directions
 - ◆ Evolve a lowest common denominator set of standards that everyone can subscribe to.
 - ◆ Pay attention to information/data quality.

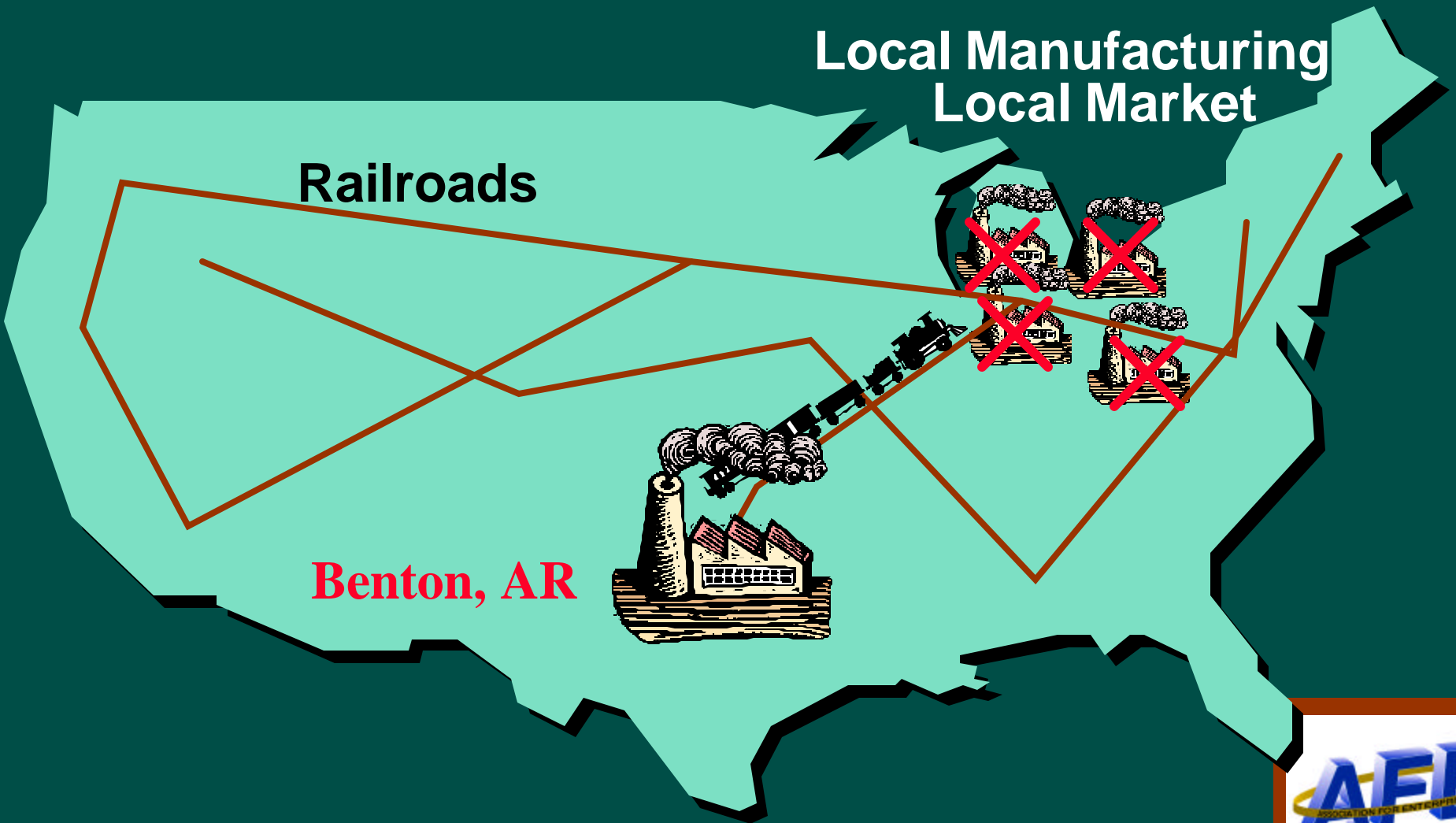


Strategy

- Recognize commodity aspect of IT
 - ◆ Emphasize cost/risk mitigation
 - ◆ Modularity/Services
- Understand uniqueness of IT
 - ◆ Technology advances
 - ◆ Embedded processes

- Are you ready for nano-technology?



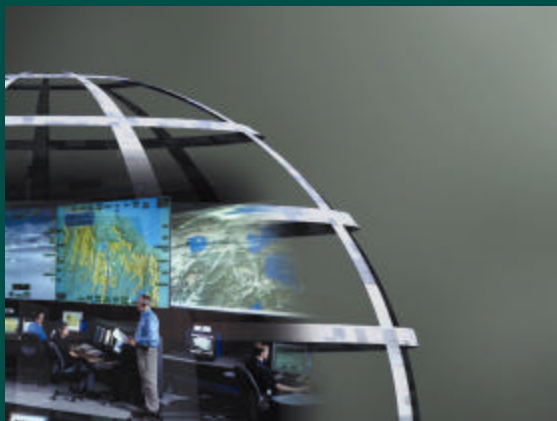
