 - During the October 2003 Meeting 23 members

 - 38 distinct members responded overall



- Number of Conferences / Meetings
 - 16 votes for 4
 - 8 votes for 3
 - 8 votes for 2
- Side comments
 - Can not justify attending a Conference without associated working meetings of the Forums
 - Several wrote that the Forums need to maintain the pace of meeting four times per year
 - Conferences are the 'best education'
 - Consider one electronic conference per year to reach out globally

- Governing Board consists of:
 - Platinum Open Group Members
 - Elected Open Group Representatives (two year term)
 - Customer Council three directors: Currently: Elaine Babcock (DoD DISA), Alan Doniger (POSC), Bill Estrem (U. of St. Thomas)
 - Supplier Council one director: Currently vacant
 - President & CEO
- Board Directors
 - Act in the best interests of The Open Group
 - Representation is exclusive of their company affiliation
 - Represent the wishes of the member constituency (elected representatives)
 - Act as ambassadors for The Open Group THE Open GROUI

- Board Director Commitment
 - Four 1 to 2 day in-person meetings per year
 - Liaison with members, gathering input and feedback
 - Interaction with other Board Directors
- Eligibility of Elected Representative Nominees
 - Any staff member of any member of the Customer or Supplier Council
 - Except Platinum members, of course
- Voting: "one vote per member organization"
 - Supplier members vote for the supplier nominees
 - Customer members vote for the customer nominees
