ArchiMate in a nutshell

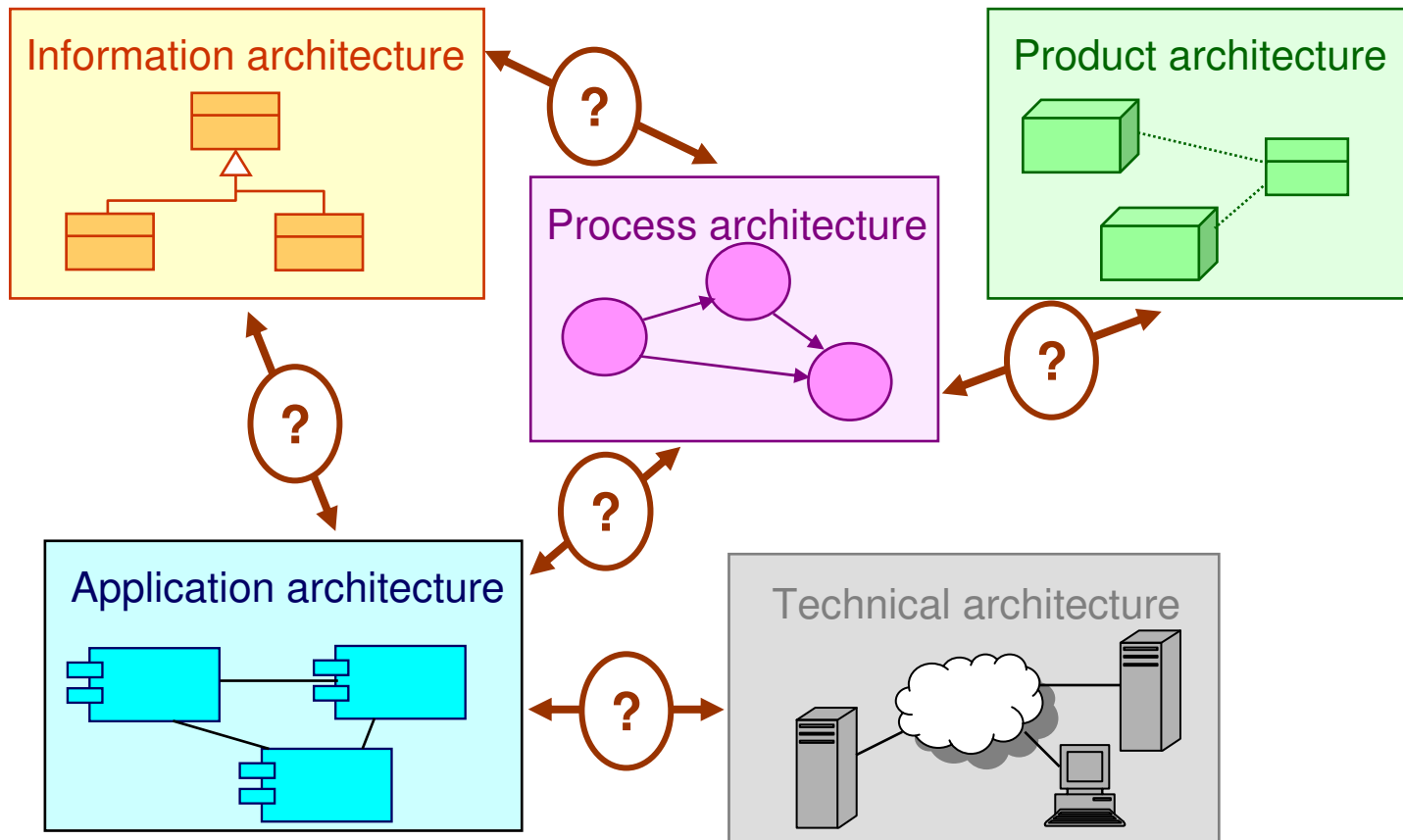
- ❑ ArchiMate is an open and independent graphical modelling language for enterprise architecture

- ❑ A true open standard

ArchiMate characteristics

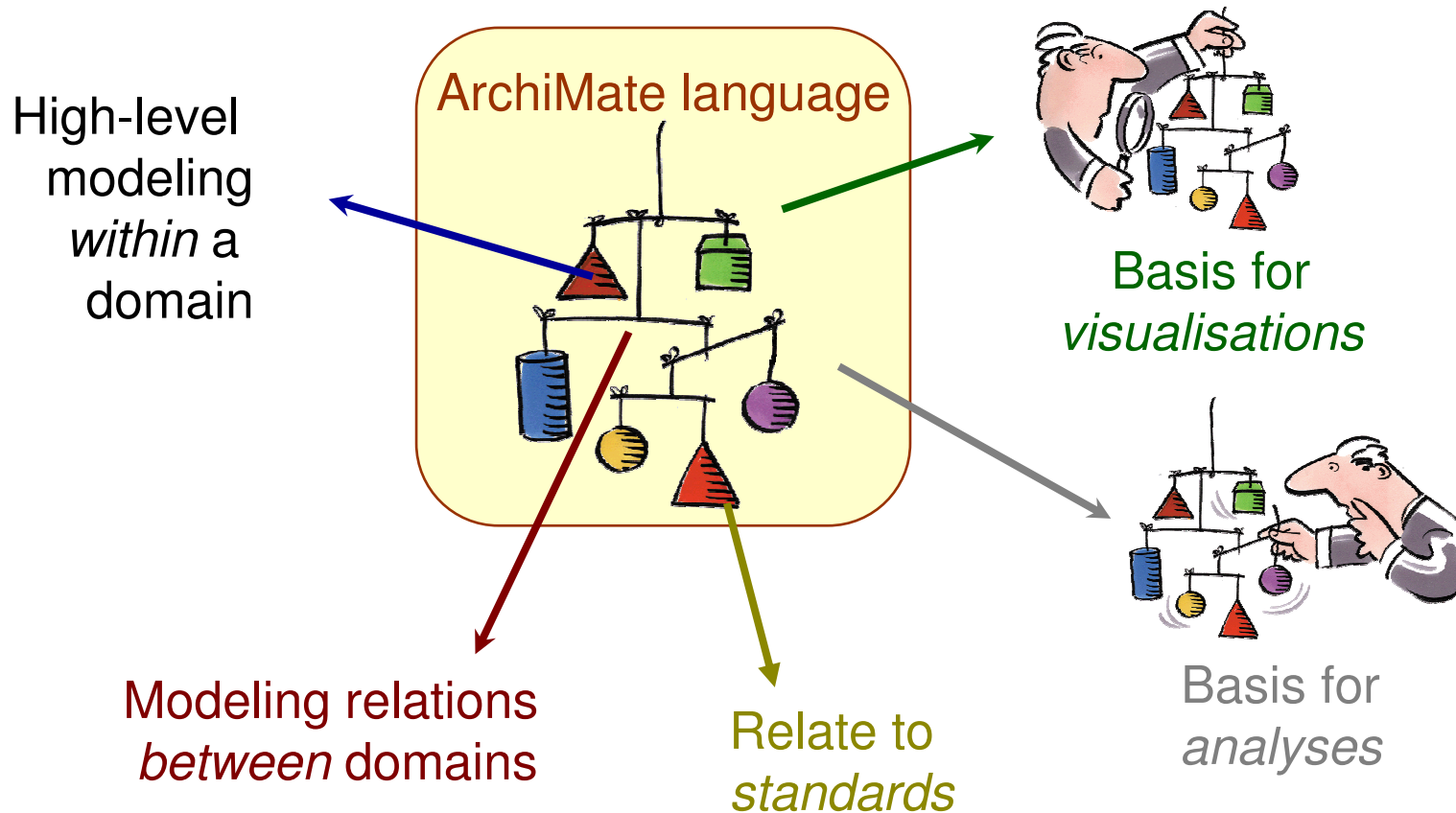
- ❑ Business, application and technology layer
- ❑ Domain models for:
 - product, process, organisation, application, information, data, technology.
- ❑ But also:
 - their interrelationships!
 - Automatic view and analysis mechanisms!
- ❑ Service paradigm in all layers
- ❑ Result: Easier communication & collaboration with stakeholders through clear models.

- ❑ Also starting point for MDA:
 - Implementation relationships to BPMN, UML

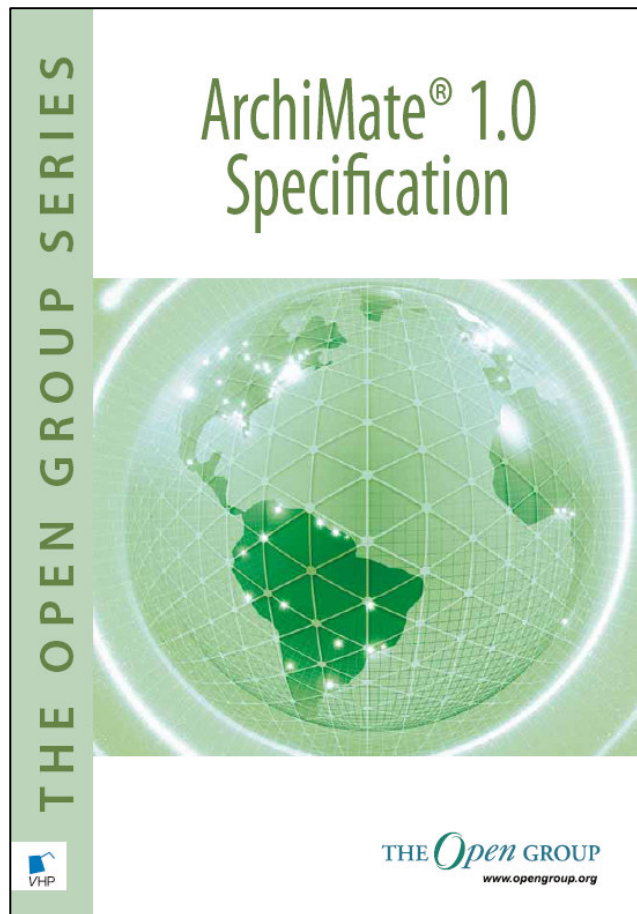

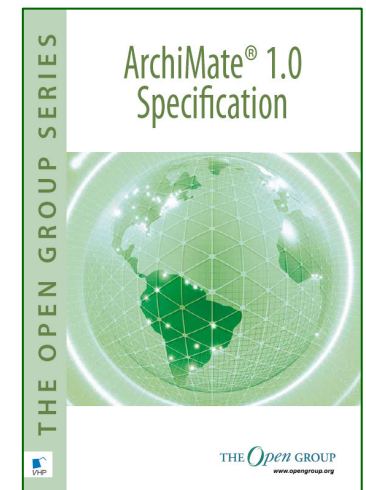
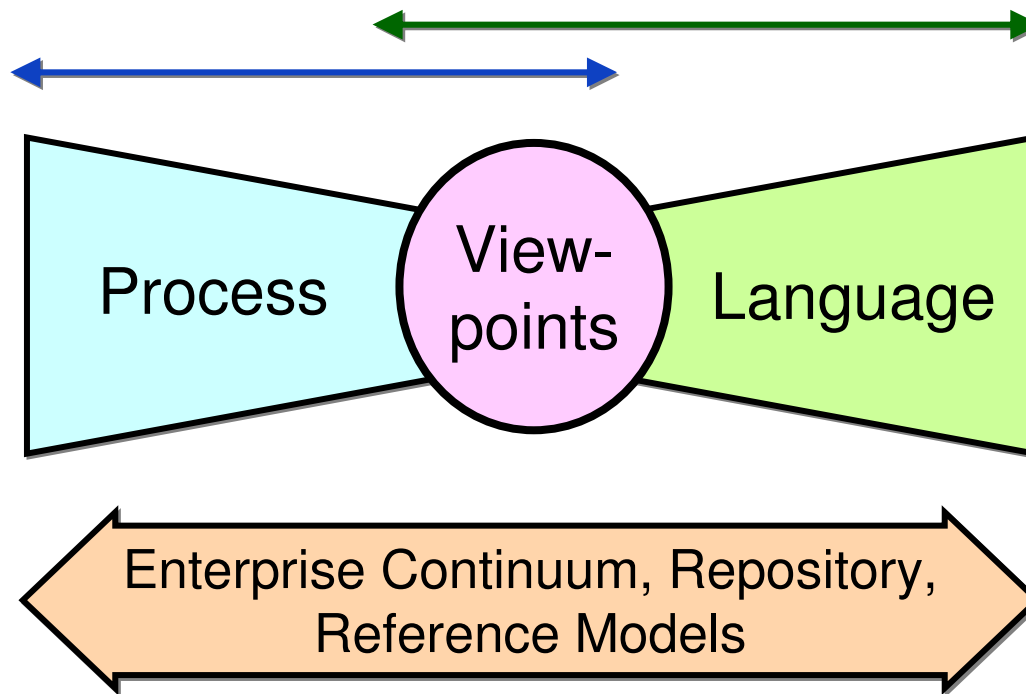
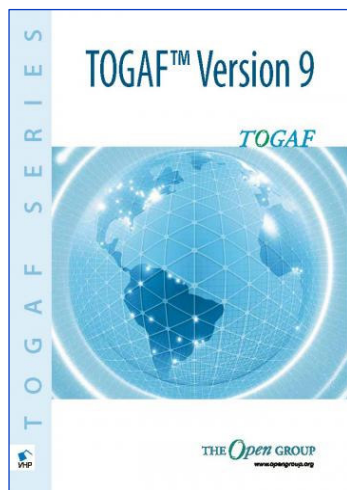
- Tools
