PRIMA ...

... is a consortium of process industry companies, headquartered in Europe and operating on a global basis.



Intended audience and purpose ...

Senior Managers in these organisations increasingly recognise the strategic importance of more effectively exploiting information assets if their organisations are to remain competitive. This document is aimed at senior decision makers in positions of authority in the process industries and is intended to inform them of PRIMA's aims for the sector and how by authorising their companies involvement they will bring about improved performance for their own companies and the sector generally.

PRIMA's Mission ...

... to realise measurable and perceived improvement in manufacturing performance in the sector, through improved exploitation of IT throughout the enterprise.

PRIMA's Aims & Objectives ...

... to maintain a common, clear and consistent view of the IT needs of the sector based on business drivers; to share best practice where competitive advantage is not compromised by so doing; and to present a sector representative voice on this topic, to the outside world;

... to encourage the IT supply base to provide products and product technologies, better suited to the needs of the

process sector and conforming to standards which are relevant to the sector;

... to encourage improved targeting of national and European research funds on the IT needs of the sector, where gaps are not likely to be addressed by the market driven commercial activities of the supply base;

PRIMA's Strategy ...

... to operate a network of process industry companies and their suppliers, aimed at exchanging views, stimulating cross-fertilisation, and encouraging targeted action;

... to maintain a coherent, business driven, IT vision for the sector:

... to manage the production of high quality requirement specifications for those critical IT functionality which currently fail to meet expectation in existing products;

... to co-ordinate external collaborative research activities which aspire to service the process sector's IT needs, including concept assessment and product certification;

'Why should I be interested?'

PRIMA is focused on realising the potential from IT for the sector and thereby protecting the future well being of it. Active participants in this process will secure competitive advantage over other companies. Failure to actively engage in this process will inevitably result in the erosion of a companies competitive position.

The increasing pressure which the process sector in Europe is facing, both at home and to its global operations, is well documented. Equally well documented is the unrealised potential for business performance transformation through the technologies of the information age.
