




The Importance of Standards Certification

- ☐ Customers want to have alternative sources from which to buy these products – not just from one vendor
- ☐ Customers demand interoperable (and interchangeable) standardized choices

- ☐ The Directory market IS standardized…but there are no guarantees that all vendor participants have implemented the "standards" the same way no certification!




Server-Server Interoperability
