


### A Bit About BITS

# Crisis Management -Telecommunications Focus

- Develop a White Paper on critical issues and potential solutions to be used for discussions.

- Draft letters addressing issues through business practices and public policies.
- Draft letters making issues known to the industry through business requirements.

# BITS Framework for Managing Technology Risk for ITSPs

Intended for use as a guiding document and set of criteria against which IT service provider relationships can be effectively evaluated and managed.

Intended to complement regulatory guidance and requirements; sets voluntary industry guidelines for risk-based management of IT service provider relationships.

#### **ITSP Framework Phase II**

- Education and Awareness: Gain broad acceptance of the BITS Framework for Managing Technology Risk for IT Service Provider Relationships among key stakeholders.
- Vendor Management: Identify and share industry best practices and considerations for relationship and risk management of IT service provider relationships.
- Crisis Management: Update BITS Framework to include crisis management/business continuity issues for service providers.
- Security Assessments: Identify industry, regulatory and Framework requirements for third-party audits and assessments.
- Cross-Border: Identify industry issues and best practices related to cross-border outsourcing.

# SRA – BITS Product Certification Program

- Improve the baseline security of products that are used in the financial services industry.
- Provide an opportunity to leverage independent testing efforts including common criteria testing.
- Provide an outward facing seal to visibly identify products that meet the criteria.





# SRA - Critical Infrastructure Assurance

- Critical Infrastructure Assurance addresses the growing interdependencies between core sectors such as telecommunications, transportation, electric power and financial services in e-commerce and requires a partnership between providers, customers and intermediaries to ensure a secure environment.
  - National Strategy for Critical Infrastructure Protection
  - Cross Sector Cooperation through the Partnership for Critical Infrastructure Security (PCIS)
  - Financial Services Information Sharing and Analysis Center (FS/ISAC)



# SRA - Operational Risk Management

- Develop a common body of high risk factors for the industry related to information security that influence operational risk models.
- Establish metrics and measurement methodologies.
- Provide sound practices for preventing the likelihood of occurrence and/or diminishing the resulting damage for information security risk events.



# **SRA - Regulation / Compliance**

- Analysis involves the SRA in sharing experiences on how regulators are interpreting the new cybersecurity and other security requirements, as well as the institutional impact of implementing these regulations
  - Gramm-Leach-Bliley Section 501B
  - FFIEC Information Systems Handbook pending update
- Periodic discussions with regulatory agencies to facilitate industry dialogue.
