
# People want IT/IS procurement to become more professional

- ⇒ 5% of procurements involve Purchasing (Buy IT)
- IT a management 'black hole', yet Europe's top 10 spends > \$15 bn a year (Spikes Cavell, 1995)
- "IT directors are over-sensitive, have a poor understanding of their organisations business, and always believe they are right" (Business & Technology)
- ⇒ IT as a mediaeval 'craft guild'
  - Procurement 'successes' and 'disasters' are about people, not technology and vice versa!



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# IT procurement lagged behind other business processes

- ⇒ European Procurement Forum top 3
  - Buyer Supplier issues, Teamworking, Skills & Training
  - Case Studies show there no rocket science in achieving improvements
  - ⇒ The issues are not unique to IT......
- ⇒ There have been breakthroughs in other business processes
  - Customer Service
  - ⇒ Manufacturing
  - ⇒ Supply chain
  - ⇒ New product development



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## **TEAM Overview**

Challenge

Improve the management of procurement teams involving purchasing, development & planning/standards personnel

#### Approach

- Identify a set of organisational improvement techniques
- Conduct experiments with 6 companies undertaking procurements
- Collect metrics for IT projects, organisation and perceptions at start and finish
- Document successful approaches



- Case studies of successful procurement team building
- Measure of improvements that can be achieved
- Defined procurement practices for further study



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### **Partner Roles**

#### ⇒ Facilitators


- Collects organisational metrics before and after experiments
- Works with users to manage experiments
- Partners: The Open Group (UK), ISQ (Portugal), IVF (Sweden)

#### ⇒ Users

- Conducts actual procurement using new approach, tool, technique or organisation structure
- Receives funding to cover costs plus partner support to assist in implementation
- User Partners:
  - Rhône Poulenc (France)
  - Swedish Defence FMV
  - Instituto Informatica (Portugal)
- UK Post Office
- Portugal Telecom
- Portuguese Transport Authority









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## **TEAM Refinements**

- Organisational metrics have also been used as a diagnostic and motivator
- Procurement teams need more assistance than anticipated
- Users are utilising project participation to motivate broader change within their organisation
- Organisational tool in the form of Procurement Team Survey has been adopted as management tool
  - Organisational metrics are clearly an exploitable result



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## **TEAM Challenges**

- Procurement teams are generally large (8-25 people) and sometimes geographically dispersed - scheduling difficult
- Building consensus at the start was very time consuming, but essential
- ⇒ IT procurement teams first choice is (yet another) tool
- ⇒ Life and business has to continue!



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## **TEAM Task Benefits**

- Clear information provided concerning how to implement team building actions and their benefits
- Additional best practice identified related to managing procurement teams
- Survey tool useful for initiating improvements and monitoring team performance
- Area of clear concern for many procurement organisations being addressed
